Holed	1	Any bunker or water hazard.	
Through the Green	2	All ground of the hole being played, which is especially prepared for putting.	
Teeing Ground	3	A player has taken his stance and has also grounded his club, except that in a hazard, the player has addressed the ball when he has taken his stance.	
Loose Impediments	4	Any agency not part of the match or in stroke play, not part of the competitor's side.	
Obstruction	5	A movable straight indicator, with or without bunting or other material attached, centered in the hole to show its position. It shall be circular in cross-section.	
Hazards	6	Anything artificial, including artificial surfaces such as roads, paths and manufactured ice.	
Outside Agency	7	Natural objects such as stones, leaves, twigs, branches and the like.	
Putting Green	8	When a ball is at rest within the circumference of the hole and all of it is below the lip of the hole.	
Stance	9	A ball that leaves its position and comes to rest in any other place.	
Addressing the Ball	10	A player placing his feet in position for and preparatory for making a stroke.	
Flagstick	11	The starting place for the hole to be played.	
Move or Moved	12	The whole area of the course except the teeing ground and putting green of the hole being played and all hazards on the course.
