Junior Pass Holder "Playing Test" Requirements

3-Hole Playing Test

First Tee – Par = 10

- Appropriately dressed
- Player introduces self and caddy to playing companions
 - Shake hands with all
- Have proper equipment available prior to commencing play
 - Announced ball type, number and markings
 - Tees
 - Ball Mark Repair Tool
 - Ball Markers or small coins

Safety – Par = 5

- Make others aware, visually or verbally, when you are ready to play
- Did not put self in any dangerous situations to be struck by a club or errant shot
- Yelled "Fore" when an airborne ball could potentially injure a maintenance worker, a playing companion, fellow-competitor or spectator

Etiquette – Par = 15

- Standing in appropriate positions, so not to interfere with playing companions peripheral vision
- Correct greenside placement of equipment
- Correctly marked and replaced the ball on the putting surface
- Walked around other players "Line of Putt"
- Flagstick duties
- Replace divots
- Repaired ball marks (minimum 2)
- Raked sand traps

Pace of Play – Par = 20

- Walked with a purpose between shots
- Played ready golf
- Pick up upon reaching maximum score (Double Par Rule in effect)
- Complete holes in the allotted time
 - Single Player Time Par = 30 Minutes
 - Twosome Time Par = 35 Minutes
 - Threesome Time Par = 40 Minutes
 - Foursome Time Par = 45 Minutes

Completion of Play – Par = 5

- Remove headwear / sunglasses
- Shook hands with all playing companions and thanked them genuinely
- Counted all clubs prior to leaving the last green

Penalty Strokes

- Add one penalty stroke for each hole not completed
- Add one penalty stroke for not knowing or demonstrating proper safety, etiquette or pace of play
