## Junior Pass Holder "Playing Test" Requirements

### **9-Hole Playing Test**

#### First Tee – Par = **15**

- Appropriately dressed
- Player introduces self and caddy to fellow-competitors
  - Shakes hands with all
- Has proper equipment available prior to commencing play
  - Balls
  - Tees
  - Pencil or writing tool
  - Ball Mark Repair Tool
  - Ball Marker or small coin
- Identifies ball type, number and markings to fellow-competitors
- Exchanged scorecards

#### Safety – Par = **5**

- Make others aware when you are going to play
- Do not put yourself in any dangerous situations to be struck by a club or errant shot
- Yelled "Fore" when an airborne ball could potentially injure a maintenance worker, a fellow-competitor or another person

#### Etiquette – Par = **20**

- Stood in appropriate positions, so not to interfere with fellow-competitors peripheral vision
- Correct greenside placement of equipment
- Flagstick duties
- Correctly marked and replaced the ball on the putting surface
- Correctly moved a marker on a fellow-competitors line-of-play
- Did not walk on or cross over a fellow-competitors line-of-play
- Replace divots
- Repaired ball marks (minimum 2)
- Raked sand traps

#### Pace of Play – Par = **20**

- Walked with a purpose between shots
- Play ready golf
- Play a provisional ball when necessary
  - Declare intentions and identified different markings of balls in play
- Picked-up upon reaching maximum score (Double Par Rule in effect)
- Complete each hole in the allotted time (13 minutes per hole)

#### Rules – Par = **20**

- Know rulings for:
  - Lost Ball / Ball Out of Bounds
  - Ball in a Lateral or Water Hazard
  - Unplayable Lie Options
  - Demonstrated how to drop a ball in a free relief or penalty situation

#### Completion of Play – Par = **2**

- Remove headwear / sunglasses
- Shook hands with fellow-competitors and genuinely thanked them

#### Scorecard – Par = **3**

- Recorded scores on the next tee box
- Return a accurate and attested scorecard

#### Penalty Strokes

- Add one penalty stroke for each hole not completed
- Add one penalty stroke for not knowing or demonstrating proper safety, etiquette, pace of play or Rules
