The Redwoods Golf Course K9 Policy

GUIDELINES FOR DOGS AND DOG OWNERS

At Redwoods we are pleased to welcome your four legged friend to enjoy a day on the course with you! Each dog owner must first consider if their dog is suitable to accompany them.

Each dog must be:

- Under adequate control of the owner (ie. on a leash, being held, or in the cart)
- Healthy and up to date on vaccinations
- Properly socialized, docile and trained to show obedience
- Able to wait quietly and patiently
- Is not reactive to noises, or golf activity, and does NOT chase balls, machinery, carts or other golfers

If deemed necessary, Redwoods Golf Course reserves the right to request proof of health record prior to allowing any dog onto the course. Redwoods staff are also permitted to test the obedience of a dog by way of the "sit" command.

Owners are responsible for:

- The behavior of their dog
- Ensuring the safety and welfare of their dog
- Ensuring their dog does not run free
- Cleaning up after their dog
- Any possible damage, including but not limited to digging, chewing, or injury to any users of the course and its facilities

Under no circumstance may a dog urinate on any putting green.

Dogs are NOT permitted on practice areas, greens, sand bunkers,
or inside the restaurant. *Patio seating is permitted seasonally

If a dog is not under adequate control of the owner (on a leash, being held or staying in the cart), in restricted areas, disrupting any other golfer with barking or bad behavior, or causing damage or injury, Redwoods employees reserve the right to remove the owner and the dog from the course. Removal may occur after warnings have been given to the owner or without warnings depending on the nature of the infraction.

EXCEPTIONS Dogs are not permitted on the course during tournaments.

This policy will be reviewed occasionally by the Redwoods Management Team and may be adjusted or revoked at any time at the sole discretion of Management.
